Jordan was one of the best all-around female athletes to ever don the blue and white. She lettered all four years in field hockey, basketball and softball, a Muncy High School record.

Jordan was the fourth girl in MHS history to reach the 1000 point plateau as she scored 1189 points in her career. She was selected to the Warrior Run all-tournament team in 2005, 2006, and 2007 and the Muncy Rotary Classic 1st in 2007. Jordan was selected to the Mid-Penn first team in 2008.

Jordan was a Mid-Penn 2nd team midfielder on the field hockey team in 2005 and was also selected to the MHS all-tournament team in 2007.

Jordan received the PIAA District IV Outstanding female athlete award in 2008, the Sun Gazette top female senior in 2008 and received the athletic booster club award for academic excellence, the Paul F. Gresh Memorial award all in 2008.

In college at Mansfield University, Jordan played one year of field hockey before concentrating on softball. She lettered four years on the softball team and excelled as a superb outfielder. During her career she started 22 of 26 games her freshman year, 14 of 23 her sophomore year while hitting .357,16 of 24 her junior year and 20 of 25 games her senior year.

Jordan was a PSAC all four years, a Mansfield University Presidential scholar athlete 3 years and a NFCA All-American Scholar her senior year.
