John's love for sports started as a youth and in high school. John concentrated his efforts on mainly two sports, baseball and basketball. He had an outstanding 5-year Little League career and went on to play intermediate baseball for 3 years, American Legion baseball for 3 years and 3 years on the Muncy town team in the West Branch League. He participated in basketball through his years at MHS and lettered his junior and senior years.

After serving in the US Army three years that included a tour in Vietnam, John was asked if he was interested in coaching Little League baseball. He said yes, and from that year 1972, he's been coaching baseball or basketball ever since.

Coached four 1000 point scorers. John was selected as "Coach of the Year" twice and his a two time recipient of District IV's Coaches Sportsmanship award as honored by local referee chapter.
